Requirements

- Are suggested to commit at least 25 hours of volunteer service per year for the adults and 15 hours for high school students.
- Must be willing to do the job to the best of his/her ability and are dependable.
- Must adhere to volunteer & hospital rules and policies.
- Must be at least 14 years of age.

Volunteers always:

- Promote the image of the hospital and staff.
- Promote an understanding and appreciation of hospital goals, services and needs.
- Avoid disruption of operations while serving as a volunteer.
